Content of the report:

The Management Board of Bank Gospodarstwa Krajowego (hereinafter "BGK") hereby informs that on May 27, 2020 the Prime Minister of Poland Mateusz Morawiecki appointed Tomasz Robaczyński as a member of the Management Board of BGK.

Tomasz Robaczyński will supervise the area of commissioned activities.

The new member of the Management Board of BGK is a lawyer, a graduate of the Faculty of Law and Administration at the University of Warsaw. He also obtained a completion certificate of art history (Institute of Art History of the University of Warsaw). He is the author and co-author of publications concerning public finance discipline.

Tomasz Robaczyński was associated with the Ministry of Finance in Poland for over 20 years. Since 2018 year, as the Undersecretary of State, he supervised the state budget, an operation of the EU funds and a financing budgetary, economic and local government area. Between 2007 and 2018 year he was a director of the Paying Authority Department of the Ministry of Finance, which manages of funds receiving from the European funds budget and supervises an operation of budget co-financing. Before that, from 2004 to 2007 year he managed one of the unit in above-mentioned department.
