Content of the report:

The Management Board of Bank Gospodarstwa Krajowego (hereinafter "BGK") hereby informs that on July 30, 2020 the Prime Minister of Poland Mateusz Morawiecki appointed Honorata Krysiewicz as a member of the Supervisory Board of BGK. The new member of the Supervisory Board of BGK graduated from University of Warsaw in the fields of journalism and social communication as well as European studies. Honorata Krysiewicz also obtained an Executive Master of Business Administration diploma at Collegium Humanum Warsaw Management University.

Since 2018, Honorata Krysiewicz has been working at the Chancellery of the Prime Minister - currently as the Director of the Government Work Programming Department and the Secretary of the Government Work Programming Team, and previously as the Deputy Director of the Parliamentary Affairs Department. In 2017-2018, she was the Director of the Department of Sports Infrastructure at the Ministry of Sport and Tourism. From 2016 to 2017, she headed the Sports Unit at the Opole City Hall. Moreover, in 2015-2016 she was the Chancellor for Public Relations Proxy and the Press Spokesman of the WSB University in Opole. From 2007, for over 7 years she dealt with public relations at Telewizja POLSAT Sp. z o.o., in which, among others was the leader in the communication strategy of Polsat News and Polsat's news programs, including the main news program "Wydarzenia".

Honorata Krysiewicz is also a member of the Social Sports Council at the Minister of Sport Danuta Dmowska-Andrzejuk.
