ORDINANCE OF THE MINISTER OF FINANCE¹

of 4 May 2015

amending the Ordinance on the information that should be included in the application for a promise to enter into a DOKE Agreement and the documents that should be appended to the application

Pursuant to Article 11 paragraph 1 of the Act of 8 June 2001 on Interest-Rate Support for Fixed-Rate Export Credits (Journal of Laws No. 73, item 762 and of 2004 No. 173, item 1808) the following is ordained:

§ 1. The Minister of Finance Ordinance of 7 November 2001 on the information that should be included in the application for a promise to enter into a DOKE Agreement and the documents that should be appended to the application (Journal of Laws No. 135, item 1518 and of 2003 No. 178, item 1742, and of 2005 No. 68, item 589) is hereby amended as follows:

1) in § 3 item 1 shall be replaced by the following:

“1. The applicant is obliged to append to the application a declaration issued by the domestic supplier, drawn up in accordance with the specimen presented in Annex 2 to the Ordinance, stating that all goods and services delivered and provided under an export agreement meet the requirements provided for in the provisions laid down in Article 6 letter a of the Act of 7 July 1994 on Export Insurance guaranteed by the State Treasury (Journal of Laws of 2015, item 489) and provisions issued pursuant to Article 6 letter e of the aforementioned Act that enable them to be deemed domestic products or domestic services.”;

2) Annex No. 2 to the Ordinance shall be reworded as determined in the Annex hereto.

§ 2. The Ordinance shall enter into force 14 days after its promulgation.
